CAMPBELL MUSIC – A CELEBRATION!

Did You Know.....

Campbell has the largest curricular jazz program in the province with three vocal jazz ensembles, and four jazz band ensembles at the high school. In addition, 2 jazz bands are offered at the elementary level. This extensive program allows students of all ages and abilities the opportunity to enrich their education by learning a second language - jazz!

Campbell is the only public high school in the province to offer a curricular string orchestra program. The string orchestra, going into its fourth year, is comprised of an extraordinary group of students who love to play string instruments.

The Campbell Chamber Choirs have been provincially and nationally recognized. In 2015, The Chamber Choir received first place at the Provincial Choral Festival and received the Kiwanis Club of Regina Gallagher Memorial Award and Scholarship for the 5th year in a row. The Campbell Chamber Choir was also chosen to represent Saskatchewan (via a recording) at the National Choral Festival and were awarded Second Place at the National Finals that were held in August! The Campbell Chamber Choir is the only public high school choir in Western Canada to be accorded the honour of placing in the National Finals.

The Campbell Elementary Band Program plays an integral role in the transition of students from elementary to high school. The elementary band program offers extensive opportunities including: Grade 6 Band, Grade 7 Band, Grade 8 Band, Jazz Band, Junior Winds and the Curiosity Club for students who would like to try a second or third instrument. Grant Road, Massey, McVeety, Perry and RCS have been included in our Campbell Area. This year we welcome Hawrylak, Jack MacKenzie, Wilfrid Walker, and Wilfred Hunt Schools to our area. All students will participate in festivals and performances around the city.

Campbell has the largest Concert Band and Choral program in the province! As a performance based program, the Campbell Music Department is committed to planning educational music tours that are rewarding and fulfilling for all students. This past April, the Senior Music Ensembles performed and received world-class clinics in the Disney Studios at Disneyland, CA. The tour also included performances at the Hollywood Bowl and at St. Cross by-the-sea Episcopalian Church in Hermosa Beach. The Intermediate Ensembles performed in Edmonton in March, where they participated in clinics at the Victoria School of Performing Arts. The Junior Ensembles participated in a wonderful tour to Red Deer in May where they received clinics at Red Deer College and had the opportunity to perform in the Palliative Care Unit of Red Deer Hospital.

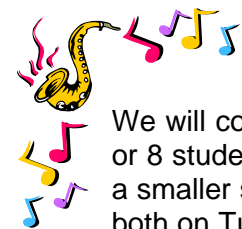

HIGH SCHOOL MUSIC FEE COLLECTION (through the Campbell Office!)

Campbell Collegiate will collect all high school music class fees directly from music families for students enrolled in high school music credit courses along with fees for their other courses. These fees include the annual registration fee for class consumables, Noon Choir and Band Fall Retreat fees, and the Grade 9 Uniform T-Shirt purchase.

The fees will be used specifically for the music program at Campbell.

This allows the school to consistently collect all fees for elective credit classes. This allows CAMPA to focus on its primary role of fundraising so all music students can continue to be enriched through clinic opportunities, elementary/secondary transition activities, and educationally based performance tours. CAMPA is committed to continuing to support the music students and staff by being positive advocates for the entire music program at Campbell.

All Grade 10-12 high school music students complete a yearly Personal Growth Project that focuses on service. One such opportunity for service is assisting CAMPA with fundraising by donating time to a Bingo.
