### **CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS FOR VOLUNTEERS**

As per school board policy, anyone who volunteers at school related activity and has direct contact with students is required to have a criminal record check completed by the Regina Police Service for Regina residents, and local RCMP detachment for those living outside city limits, and submitted to the school office. This would include but not be limited to chaperoning music tours and retreats, uniform volunteers, etc. If you have questions about criminal record checks, please contact the Campbell music teachers.

As members of the Campbell Music Program, every family has the opportunity to earn Trip Reward Points (TRPs) to offset individual costs for music tours.
