

Campbell Collegiate Associate School Volleyball Tournament

Here is a list of important details, the schedule, a basic set of rules and some expectations our school has of the visiting teams participating this year. Please read all the attached information CAREFULLY.

Date: Thursday, October 20, 2016

Time: 2:30 to 7:30 p.m. (PLEASE be on time for all games that your school is scheduled to play!!)

Location: Campbell Collegiate 102 Massey Road 523-3250

Gym 1: Girls' Draw

Gym 2: Boys' Draw

MVP T-shirts: Each coach is asked to award their tournament MVP to a deserving player on their team.

Most Sportsmanlike Award: Each coach is asked to award their most sportsmanlike player of the tournament from their own team. They will receive a mini-volleyball!!

Change Rooms: There are boys and girls change rooms in the gym, but we still suggest having your athletes change out and be ready play. Do not leave personal items unattended.

Canteen: A canteen will be available from 2:15 to 7:30 p.m. in a room between Gym 1 and Gym 2 (just to the left of the front doors when you enter the building).

- Please inform your players, coaches and parents. Snacks, drinks, popcorn, hot dogs and various other treats will be available.

Referees: Campbell Staff (one referee per court)

Scorekeepers: Campbell Students (Gr. 9-10)

*****LINESMAN:** We have this covered this year!! Student from our Ph. Ed. 9 and Wellness 10 classes will be doing this for volunteer hours. In the event somebody doesn't show, we will ask you to provide one player from your team to do this.

RULES:

1. All SVA standard rules apply.
2. ZERO tolerance of abuse toward referees/officials, scorekeepers, linesman, other coaches and canteen workers.
3. Each game is seventeen (17) minutes long. The score clock WILL NOT stop for any timeouts or substitutions.
4. There will be a short three (3) minute break in between games to allow for a quick warm-up, referee break and scorekeepers/referees change over. However, five (5) minutes will be given to each team in the second game of the day as it will be the first game they play that day. Also, five (5) minutes will be provided before the 1st Place vs. 2nd Place Playoff in each tier.
5. Scores will be kept, posted and standings recorded. A first and second place playoff game will be played at the end of each Tier 1 and Tier 2 Pool. Plaques will be awarded to the winning school of each Tier. (Tier 1 is competitive, Tier 2 is non-competitive!!)

6. Tiebreaker Rules are as follows: i) Head to Head ii) 3 Way Tie = Point Differential between common opponents.
7. **ALL players dressed in uniform must play a minimum of five (5) minutes each game in the round robin AND PLAYOFF rounds.** We ask ALL coaches to PLEASE monitor this as a team.
8. Each team will be allotted one timeout per game. (30 seconds long) However, the clock DOES NOT stop.

Schedule: This is **FINAL!!** I did my very best to accommodate all requests. re: play in a certain Tier, time slot etc. Plaques will be awarded for first place in each tier, just to make it a little more fun for the players and your schools can add them to your trophy cases!
