Re: Masks on Regina Transit – High School Students

In response to rising COVID-19 cases and to help prevent transmission of the virus in our community, we are asking Regina Transit passengers to wear masks while on public transit. Starting Saturday, September 4, masks will be required when riding Regina Transit.

Students who take the bus to and from school are required to wear a mask while aboard the bus, including those who may be vaccinated.

Enhanced cleaning continues on all Regina Transit conventional and paratransit buses which includes being sanitized daily using a hospital grade disinfectant by trained cleaning professionals. As always, it's recommended passengers follow the best practices of public health, such as staying home if feeling sick and sanitizing hands before and after each bus ride.
